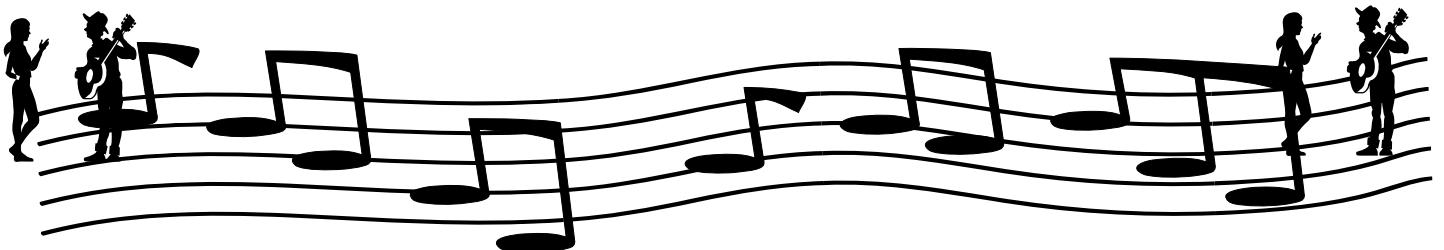

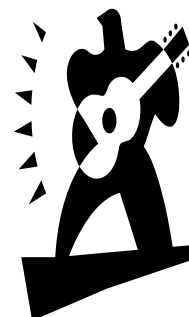

I am taking orders for our club jackets & shirts please come & see me if you would like one.

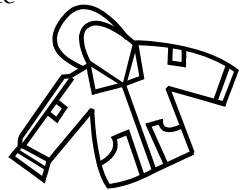
